### Summary (as of Mar 15, 2001)

Requires anyone engaged in the retail sales of cigarette products to place such products under or behind a counter and not out on the floor of the sales facility.

Deems noncompliance to be a violation of the Federal Trade Commission Act prohibition against deceptive acts or practices.
