Summary (as of Mar 27, 2001)

Parolee LEADS Public Safety Grant Program Act of 2001 - Authorizes the Attorney General to make grants to eligible States to carry out an automated data system to provide information regarding parolees to local law enforcement agencies within the State.

Requires that: (1) such a system include specified information about parolees; (2) the information be maintained in a database that can be accessed and processed by a local law enforcement agency using a remote desktop computer system; and (3) each local law enforcement agency having jurisdiction be provided the information included in the system upon a parolee's release and thereafter have access to such information upon request.
