#### **Summary** (as of Aug 2, 2001)

China Free Enterprise Act of 2001 - Prohibits any security issued by, or other interest or participation in, a Chinese Government state-owned enterprise from being listed (or authorized for listing) on the New York Stock Exchange or the American Stock Exchange, the National Market System of the Nasdag Stock Market, or on a national securities exchange (or tier or segment thereof) or by a registered securities association.
