Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 581) to authorize the Secretary of the Interior and the Secretary of Agriculture to use funds appropriated for wildland fire management in the Department of the Interior and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2001, to reimburse the United States Fish and Wildlife Service and the National Marine Fisheries Service to facilitate the interagency cooperation required under the Endangered Species Act of 1973 in connection with wildland fire management.

- **May 9, 2001:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote.(text: CR H2050)
- **May 9, 2001:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote. (text: CR H2050)
- **May 9, 2001:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **May 8, 2001:** Introduced in House
- **May 8, 2001:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 107-59, by Mr. Hastings (WA).
- **May 8, 2001:** Rule provides for consideration of H.R. 581 with 1 hour of general debate. Previous question shall be considered as ordered without intervening motions except motion to recommit with or without instructions. All points of order against provisions in the bill are waived. Measure will be considered read. Bill is open to amendments.
- **May 8, 2001:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 22.
