Fairness for Florida's Veterans Act - Directs the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to establish a second veterans benefits office in Florida.

Directs the Secretary to report to Congress a plan for the near- and long-term reduction of the backlog of claims for benefits pending at the Bay Pines, Florida, veterans benefits office.
