#### **Summary** (as of Jul 10, 2001)

Calls for U.S. corporations to make greater contributions to faith-based organizations battling societal challenges. Expresses the sense of Congress that such corporations: (1) are important partners with government in efforts to overcome social problems; and (2) should not adopt policies that prohibit contributions to faith-based organizations that are successfully advancing philanthropic causes.

- Jul 11, 2001: Received in the Senate and referred to the Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs.
- Jul 10, 2001: Mr. Whitfield moved to suspend the rules and agree to the resolution.

- Jul 10, 2001: DEBATE The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Con. Res. 170.
