Summary (as of Jan 24, 2001)

Retired Pay Restoration Act of 2001 - Permits retired members of the armed forces with service-connected disabilities to be paid both military retired pay and veterans' disability compensation.

Repeals a special compensation program for certain severely disabled military retirees.
