Expresses the sense of the Senate that the United States should make a substantial new investment this year in bioterrorism preparedness and response, including: (1) improving State and local preparedness capabilities, hosp response capabilities, disaster response medical systems, and the National Pharmaceutical Stockpile program; (2 upgrading the capabilities of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC); (3) targeting research for therapeutics and vaccines for bioterrorist agents and food safety activities; and (4) increasing international cooper securing biological agents, increasing surveillance, and retraining biological warfare specialists.	2)
