Burnt, Malheur, Owyhee, and Powder River Basin Water Optimization Feasibility Study Act of 2001 - Authorizes the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a feasibility study on water optimization in the Burnt River basin, Malheur River basin, Owyhee River basin, and Powder River basin, Oregon. Authorizes appropriations.
