Previous question shall be considered as ordered without intervening motions except motion to recommit with or without instructions. Waives all points of order against consideration of the bill. Measure will be considered read. Specified amendments are in order. The amendment printed in part A of H. Rept. 107-178 considered as adopted. Makes in order only those amendments printed in part B of H. Rept. 107-178. Authorizes a motion for the House to go to conference with the Senate on H.R. 4.
- **Aug 1, 2001:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 65.
- **Aug 1, 2001:** Considered as privileged matter. (consideration: CR H4944-5007)
- **Aug 1, 2001:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 216.
- **Aug 1, 2001:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 221 - 208 (Roll no. 306).
