Amends the Agricultural Market Transition Act to terminate the peanut price support program.

Amends the Agricultural Adjustment Act of 1938 to terminate the peanut marketing quota program.

Prohibits the Secretary of Agriculture from making price supports available for the 2001 and subsequent peanut crops.
