Summary

(as of Jun 28, 2001)

Authorizes the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, upon licensee request, to extend the time period during which the licensee is required to commence construction of a specified hydroelectric project in Pennsylvania for three consecutive two-year periods.

Allows for reinstatement of an expired license.
