Honoring the Choctaw and Comanche Code Talkers Act - Authorizes the President to award a gold medal on behalf of Congress to the Choctaw and Comanche code talkers in recognition of their contributions in performing a communications operation that assisted in saving countless lives during World War I and World War II.
