Arsenic-Treated Wood Mandatory Labeling Act - Amends the Agricultural Marketing Act of 1946 to require that a specified warning label be affixed to arsenic-treated wood sold in the United States.

- **Aug 14, 2001:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Department Operations, Oversight, Nutrition and Forestry.
- **Aug 2, 2001:** Introduced in House
- **Aug 2, 2001:** Referred to the Committee on Agriculture, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
