Provides that the amendment recommended by the Committee on Ways and Means now printed in the bill, modified by the amendment printed in the House Report 107-323 shall be considered as adopted. Measure will be considered read. Bill is closed to amendments.
- **Dec 5, 2001:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 105.

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
