Rural Exemption Enhancement Act of 2001 - Amends the Communication Act of 1934 to establish a separate process for State commission evaluation of rural and small telephone company exemptions, suspensions, or modifications for advanced telecommunication capabilities (as opposed to voice telecommunications services).
