Summary (as of Nov 30, 2001)

Medicare Laboratory Services Access Act of 2001 - Amends title XVIII (Medicare) of the Social Security Act (SSA) to specify as \$5.25 for 2002, adjusted for inflation in each subsequent year, the nominal fee for collecting specimens for clinical diagnostic laboratory tests under Medicare.

Actions Timeline

- **Dec 10, 2001:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Nov 30, 2001:** Introduced in House
- **Nov 30, 2001:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E2184)
- **Nov 30, 2001:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
