Summary (as of Dec 19, 2001)

New Hope in Housing Act - Makes religious organizations eligible project owners under: (1) the supportive housing for the elderly program (Housing Act of 1959); and (2) the supportive housing for persons with disabilities program (Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act).

Makes religious organizations eligible subrecipients under: (1) the HOME investment partnerships program (Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act); and (2) the community development block grant program (Housing and Community Development Act of 1974).
