- **Mar 7, 2002:** On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by voice vote. (text: CR H742)
- **Mar 7, 2002:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
- **Mar 6, 2002:** Introduced in House
- **Mar 6, 2002:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 107-367, by Ms. Pryce (OH).
- **Mar 6, 2002:** It shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill H.R. 3090 with the Senate amendment thereto, and to consider in the House a motion to agree to the Senate amendment, with a further amendment. The motion shall be debatable for one hour, equally divided and controlled.
- **Mar 6, 2002:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 129.
