Summary (as of Jan 31, 2001)

Child Care Safety Act of 2001 - Amends the Child Care and Development Block Grant Act of 1990 to direct the Secretary of Health and Human Services to: (1) provide to each eligible child care provider receiving funds under such Act a copy of the Consumer Product Safety Commission child care center safety standards, which such providers shall post in their child care facilities where they can be easily read; and (2) report to Congress with recommendations for encouraging compliance by such providers with such standards.

Actions Timeline

- **Mar 15, 2001:** Referred to the Subcommittee on 21st Century Competitiveness.
- **Feb 14, 2001:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Chairman.
- **Jan 31, 2001:** Introduced in House
- **Jan 31, 2001:** Referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
