Monica Kristina Rodriguez Pier Safety Study - Directs the Secretary of the Army, acting through the Chief of Engineers, to conduct a study to improve pier safety standards in navigable waters. Requires the Secretary to submit a report on the study's findings to appropriate Congressional committees.
