## Summary (as of Feb 13, 2002)

Reserve Component Tax Assistance Act of 2002 - Amends the Internal Revenue Code to allow as a business or trade deduction the expenses of a member of the reserve component of the U.S. armed forces in connection with such service. Makes such deduction available to itemizers and non-itemizers.

Establishes related reserve component business-related employment and self-employment credits.
