Shop Grant Extension Act - Amends the Housing Opportunity Program Extension Act of 1996, with respect to grants made available to self-help housing providers for FY 1998, to provide a 48-month period before funds are subject to recapture based upon failure to use the funds, or to fulfill grant terms.
