San Rafael Western Frontier National Heritage Area Act - Establishes the San Rafael Western Frontier National Heritage Area in Utah. Designates the San Rafael Heritage Council as the Area's local coordinating entity that shall prepare and submit a heritage plan.

Bars the use of Federal funds received under this Act to acquire real property.
