Summary (as of Mar 6, 2002)

Directs the Secretary of Agriculture to convey to the State of Florida: (1) National Forest System lands underlying the George Kirkpatrick Dam on the Ocklawaha River near Palatka, Florida; (2) National Forest System lands laying below the 21-foot National Geodetic Vertical Datum underlying the Rodman Reservoir formed by such dam; and (3) National Forest tract #C-615. Conditions such conveyance on the State agreeing to assume responsibility for environmental remediation activities.
