Port Chicago Naval Magazine National Memorial Study Act - Directs the Secretary of the Interior to: (1) conduct a special resource study to determine the suitability and feasibility of including the Port Chicago Naval Magazine National Memorial as a unit of the National Park System; and (2) examine potential links between the Memorial and other World War II home front sites in the San Francisco Bay area.
