- **Oct 1, 2002:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H. Res. 398.
- **Oct 1, 2002:** At the conclusion of debate, the chair put the question on the motion to suspend the rules. Mr. Green (TX) objected to the vote on the grounds that a quorum was not present. Further proceedings on the motion were postponed. The point of no quorum was withdrawn.
