Summary (as of Apr 10, 2002)

Amends the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to suspend, through December 31, 2007, the duty on cathode-ray data/graphic display tubes, color, with a phosphor dot screen pitch smaller than 0.4 mm, and with a less than 90 degree deflection.
