### **Summary** (as of May 9, 2002)

Methamphetamine Elimination Act of 2002 - Directs the Secretary of Health and Human Services to treat pseudoephedrine as a drug that, under the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act, may only be dispensed by a written prescription of a licensed practitioner.
