Directs the Secretary of the Interior, through the Bureau of Reclamation, to conduct and report to Congress on a feasibility study for developing a water treatment and distribution system for the Santee Sioux Tribe of Nebraska.

Requires the Secretary to enter into a cooperative agreement with the Tribe, at its request, for activities necessary to the conduct of such study. Authorizes appropriations.
