Cocopah Lands Act - Requires the Secretary of the Interior to take certain land in Yuma County, Arizona, in trust for the benefit of the Tribe if the Cocopah Tribe of Arizona transfers title to such land to the Secretary. Prohibits gaming under the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act.
