Summary (as of Sep 19, 2002)

Declares the sense of the House of Representatives that Congress should complete action on the Permanent Death Tax Repeal Act of 2002, and present it to the President before adjournment.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 19, 2002:** Rule H. Res. 527 passed House.
- **Sep 19, 2002:** Considered under the provisions of rule H. Res. 527. (consideration: CR H6393-6403)
- **Sep 19, 2002:** Rule provides for consideration of H. Res. 525 and H. Res. 524. Measures will be considered read. Bill is closed to amendments.
- **Sep 19, 2002:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 524.
- **Sep 19, 2002:** The previous question was ordered pursuant to the rule.
- **Sep 19, 2002:** POSTPONED ROLL CALL VOTE - At the conclusion of debate the Speaker pro tempore put the question on adoption of the resolution and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. Mr. Nussle demanded the Yeas and Nays and pursuant to clause 8, Rule XX, further proceedings on the adoption of the resolution were postponed.
- **Sep 19, 2002:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H6403-6404)
- **Sep 19, 2002:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 242 - 158 (Roll no. 401).(text: CR H6393)
- **Sep 19, 2002:** Motion to reconsider laid on the table Agreed to without objection.
