Summary (as of Sep 24, 2002)

Directs the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, upon licensee request, to extend for three consecutive two-year periods the time period during which the licensee is required to commence construction of a specified hydroelectric project in the State of Oregon.

Provides for license reinstatement if the period required for commencement of project construction has expired before enactment of this Act.
