Summary (as of Sep 25, 2002)

Expresses the sense of the House of Representatives that the Congress should complete action in the 107th Congress on the Retirement Security Savings Act of 2002 and should present such legislation to the President for his signature prior to adjournment, so that workers can be assured that certain pension reforms under current law, which are permanently extended by such Act, will not be eliminated.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 25, 2002:** Rule H. Res. 547 passed House.
- **Sep 25, 2002:** Considered under the provisions of rule H. Res. 547. (consideration: CR H6678-6681)
- **Sep 25, 2002:** Rule provides for consideration of H. Res. 540, H. Res. 543 and H. Res. 544. Measure will be considered read. Bill is closed to amendments.
- **Sep 25, 2002:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 544.
- **Sep 25, 2002:** The previous question was ordered pursuant to the rule.
- **Sep 25, 2002:** POSTPONED ROLL CALL VOTE - At the conclusion of debate, the Chair put the question on adoption of the resolution and by voice vote, announced that the ayes had prevailed. The Yeas and Nays were demanded and pursuant to the rule, the Chair postponed further proceedings on the adoption of the resolution until later in the legislative day.
- **Sep 25, 2002:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H6681-6682)
- **Sep 25, 2002:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 291 - 118 (Roll no. 415).(text: CR H6678)
