Expresses support for the decision of the U.S. Government to offer and solicit co-sponsorship for a resolution at the 57th Session of the United Nations Human Rights Commission in Geneva, Switzerland, calling upon the Government of the People's Republic of China to end its human rights abuses in China and Tibet. Urges the U.S. Government to take the lead in organizing multilateral support to obtain passage of such resolution.
