Summary (as of Oct 16, 2002)

Declares a named individual (Mounir Adel Hajjar) to be eligible for issuance of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status to that of an alien lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent residence under the Immigration and Nationality Act.

Denies any preferential immigration treatment for specified relatives of the individual.
