English Language Acquisition Funding Fairness Act - Amends the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (ESEA) to eliminate a funding limitation applicable to grants for special alternative instructional programs for limited English proficient students, under ESEA provisions for bilingual education capacity and demonstration grants.
