Summary (as of Mar 30, 2001)

Pet Safety and Protection Act of 2001 - Amends the Animal Welfare Act regarding permissible sources of research facility dogs and cats, which include licensed dealers, registered public pounds or shelters meeting specified requirements, and research facilities licensed by the Department of Agriculture. Establishes monetary penalties for related violations.
