Federal Acupuncture Coverage Act of 2001 - Provides for coverage of qualified acupuncturist services under part B (Supplementary Medical Insurance) of title XVIII (Medicare) of the Social Security Act (as amended by the Medicare, Medicaid, and SCHIP Benefits Improvement and Protection Act of 2000) and under the Federal Employees Health Benefits Program.

- **Mar 14, 2001:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Mar 7, 2001:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Mar 5, 2001:** Referred to the Subcommittee on the Civil Service and Agency Organization.

- **Feb 27, 2001:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, and Government Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
