Extends sympathy to the family of Ron Sander, who was killed by terrorists, and salutes his courage. Supports the U.S. commitment to bringing the killers and the kidnappers to justice.

Expresses the sense of Congress that the United States must redouble its efforts to prevent future kidnappings.
