Summary (as of May 22, 2001)

Grand Canyon Capital Improvements Act of 2001 - Authorizes the Secretary of the Interior to enter into a memorandum of agreement with an entity to act as an authorized fund raising organization for the benefit of the Grand Canyon National Park. Requires the organization to issue taxable bonds in return for a surcharge or set-aside for the Park.

Authorizes the Secretary to set aside up to \$2 per person from park entrance fees, or to assess an additional \$2 per person, to amortize the bond issue, cover the reasonable costs of administration, and maintain a sufficient reserve.

Authorizes use of bond proceeds for Park facilities.
