### Summary (as of Mar 8, 2001)

Racial Profiling Prohibition Act of 2001 - Directs the Secretary of Transportation to withhold specified Federal highway fund apportionments for a State that fails to adopt and enforce standards that prohibit the use of racial profiling in the enforcement of State laws regulating the use of Federal-aid highways.
