Healthy and High Performance Schools Act of 2001 - Establishes in the Department of Education a High Performance Schools Program.

Authorizes the Secretary of Education to award grants to States to provide subgrants to local educational agencies for renovation projects to make existing elementary school and secondary school buildings energy-efficient and environmentally healthy.
