### Summary (as of May 22, 2003)

Veterans' Prescription Drug Reform Act of 2003 - Authorizes the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to allow pharmacies of the Department of Veterans Affairs to dispose medications pursuant to a valid prescription written by a private practitioner to any veteran who is on a waiting list for a first appointment with the Department for medical services.
