Summary (as of Mar 18, 2003)

Deems Pamela S. Konkel of Troy, Illinois, a widow who has attained the age of 60 for purposes of the Social Security Act (effective October 31, 2002). States that any widow's insurance benefits to which Ms. Konkel is entitled for the period prior to the enactment of this Act shall be paid in a lump sum.
