Summary (as of May 8, 2003)

(This measure has not been amended since it was reported to the House on May 6, 2003. The summary of that version is repeated here.)

Declares that there shall be paid, out of the applicable accounts of the House of Representatives, not more than specified amounts for certain committees of the House of Representatives in the 108th Congress. Sets forth first session and second session limitations. Allows the Committee on House Administration to adjust the total allowed for any of the named committees under specified circumstances.
