### Summary (as of Nov 6, 2003)

Extends by ten years the ban on undetectable firearms under the Undetectable Firearms Act of 1988 (which makes it illegal to manufacture, import, possess, or transfer a firearm that is not detectable by walk-through metal detectors or airport x-ray machines).
