Montgomery GI Bill Flexibility Act of 2003 - Extends the period of entitlement to educational assistance under the Montgomery GI Bill to 14 (currently, ten) years after the date of an individual's last discharge or release from active duty.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 9, 2003:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E1175-1176)
- **Jun 4, 2003:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Readiness.
- **Jun 4, 2003:** Executive Comment Requested from DOD.
- **May 21, 2003:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Benefits.
- **May 1, 2003:** Introduced in House
- **May 1, 2003:** Referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, and in addition to the Committee on Armed Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
