Summary (as of Sep 23, 2004)

Pledge Protection Act of 2004 - Amends the Federal judicial code to deny jurisdiction to any Federal court, and appellate jurisdiction to the Supreme Court, to hear or decide any question pertaining to the interpretation of the Pledge of Allegiance or its validity under the Constitution. Makes this limitation inapplicable to the Superior Court of the District of Columbia or the District of Columbia Court of Appeals.

Actions Timeline

- Sep 27, 2004: Received in the Senate.
- Sep 23, 2004: Considered under the provisions of rule H. Res. 781. (consideration: CR H7451-7478; text of measure as reported in House: CR H7470)
- Sep 23, 2004: Rule provides for consideration of H.R. 2028 with 1 hour of general debate. Previous question shall be considered as ordered without intervening motions except motion to recommit with or without instructions. Measure will be considered read. Specified amendments are in order.
- Sep 23, 2004: House resolved itself into the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union pursuant to H. Res. 781 and Rule XVIII.
- Sep 23, 2004: The Speaker designated the Honorable Mike Pence to act as Chairman of the Committee.
- Sep 23, 2004: GENERAL DEBATE The Committee of the Whole proceeded with one hour of general debate on H.R. 2028.
- Sep 23, 2004: DEBATE Pursuant to the provisions of H.Res. 781, the Committee of the Whole proceeded with 10 minutes of debate on the Sensenbrenner amendment.
- Sep 23, 2004: DEBATE Pursuant to the provisions of H.Res. 781, the Committee of the Whole proceeded with 20 minutes of debate on the Watt amendment.
- Sep 23, 2004: POSTPONED VOTE At the conclusion of debate on the Watt amendment, the Chair put the question on adoption of the amendment and by voice vote, announced that the noes had prevailed. Mr. Watt demanded a recorded vote and the Chair postponed further proceedings until later in the legislative day.
- Sep 23, 2004: DEBATE Pursuant to the provisions of H.Res. 781, the Committee of the Whole proceeded with 10 minutes of debate on the Jackson-Lee amendment.
- Sep 23, 2004: UNFINISHED BUSINESS The Chair announced that the unfinished business was the question on adoption of the Watt amendment which had been debated earlier and on which further proceedings had been postponed.
- Sep 23, 2004: The House rose from the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union to report H.R. 2028.
- Sep 23, 2004: The previous question was ordered pursuant to the rule.
- Sep 23, 2004: Passed/agreed to in House: On passage Passed by the Yeas and Nays: 247 173 (Roll no. 467).
