Summary (as of Mar 11, 2004)

Amends the Solid Waste Disposal Act to require: (1) secondary containment of any new or replaced underground storage tank system; and (2) the monitoring for leaks of the space between the primary and secondary containment if the new or replaced tank or piping are within 1,000 feet of a community water system, potable drinking water well, or other sensitive area.

Establishes civil penalties for a violation of these requirements.

Actions Timeline

- Mar 25, 2004: Star Print ordered on the bill.
- Mar 11, 2004: Introduced in Senate
- Mar 11, 2004: Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR 3/12/2004 S2723-2724)
- Mar 11, 2004: Read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works.
